IDENTITY IN CRISIS: DANIEL'S VISION FOR THE FUTURE

This week, just a few miles from the Estes building, around 160 preachers and teachers will be at Freed-Hardeman speaking on the 81st Annual Freed-Hardeman Bible Lectureship. The FHU Lectureship is unique in its 81 years of heritage, but also is unique in what it offers to those who attend. You will find that the program seeks a balance between the academic and practical application of texts, themes, and key questions from Scripture and from the trials of ministry. The 2017 theme, "Identity in Crisis: Daniel's Vision for the Future," matches both our striving for an exploration of the text and an application to ministry - from the beginning of the program to the very end. Daniel tells the story of how God's people would be preserved despite the challenges that they faced both from within and without. Readers of Daniel are challenged to consider the power of the Most High God who is far greater than any earthly ruler.

Many of the features of past lectureships are still in place, including a focus on the text of Daniel (which includes the less familiar material of chapters 7-12), Open Forum (featuring a three-man panel), and a number of sessions especially for children, teens, women, missionaries, young families, businesspeople, and those just simply interested in studying the Bible. There are at least five major features of the program in 2017 that are different than past years. There is a series organized by the FHU College of Business on best business practices, a series on how we got the Bible, a series of presentations on methods for personal evangelism, lessons designed especially for those giving long-term care to loved ones, and a series on Islam presented by a brother in Christ who grew up in Baghdad and studied the Bible to find the truth. If you can't attend the lectures in person you can register as a "virtual attendee" and watch the main floor sessions for free online. Please pray for this effort and make plans to participate either in person or online.

Room). There are also presentations being made by gospel meeting speakers from 2016 Keith Parker (Tuesday @ 9:30am, Loyd Aud Main Floor) and 2017 Bill Watkins (Wednesday @ 9:30, Loyd Aud Main Floor). Finally, please note that on Wednesday night, February 8, @ 6:00pm (time of Wednesday service will be changed for the week of lectures) our speaker will be Neal Pollard from the Bear Valley church of Christ in Denver, CO. Neal is a great preacher of the Gospel who will be one of the panelists during Open Forum next week. It needs to also be noted that a number of other Estes members contribute in major ways to the Lectureship through administrative service, helping edit the book, with the FHU Associates, or in dozens of other ways. With your help and prayers we are truly looking forward to a great week!

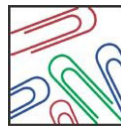

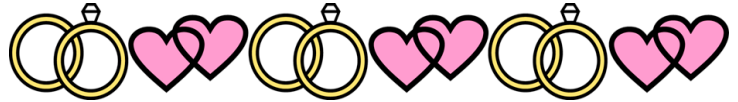
