Remembering God's Language of Love in our "Love" Saturated World

"In the Spring a young man's fancy lightly turns to thoughts of love." —Alfred, Lord Tennyson "Locksley Hall"

Next week, American culture will be overflowing with images of romantic love and tokens of affection. Those signs take on an array of forms from sexual passion to declarations of friendly, familial, and loyal devotion. While Valentine's Day is principally associated with what we think of as romantic love, Christians know and strive for a deeper version of what the world calls "love." This week, when our attention is focused on love, we might be reminded of the seeming inadequacy of the English language to cover all of the aspects of "love"—a word that we use to refer to the feelings and connections we have for everything from football, pizza, and coffee to our spouses, children, and our creator. Remember that the Greek language does a better job of accounting for the different relationships—say the one between a man and his supper and the one between a man and his wife, or even the one between a man and his God. The Greek language has at least eight words that account for these relationships—1. "eros," erotic, sometimes uncontrollable love; 2. "phileo," affectionate, brotherly love; 3. "ludus," playful love which includes flirtation and childlike love; 4. "mania," obsessive love; 5. "pragma," practical, mutually beneficial love; 6. "philautia," self love which includes both a healthy self-esteem and an unhealthy narcissistic condition; 7. "storge," long-term affection and devotion, often associated with the love of parents for their children; and "agape," the universal and unconditional kind of love that God has for us and that we strive to emulate. God's word teaches us what "love" looks like as we continue to learn God's love. Here are just a few samples:

- *A new commandment I give to you, that you love one another, even as I have loved you, that you also love one another. By this all men will know that you are My disciples, if you have love for one another. -- John 13:34-35*
- *Be devoted to one another in brotherly love; give preference to one another in honor. -- Romans 12:10*
- *Owe nothing to anyone except to love one another; for he who loves his neighbor has fulfilled the law. -- Romans 13:8*
- *May the Lord cause you to increase and abound in love for one another, and for all people, just as we also do for you. -- 1 Thessalonians 3:12*
- *Let us consider how to stimulate one another to love and good deeds. -- Hebrews 10:24*
- *Above all, keep fervent in your love for one another, because love covers a multitude of sins. -- 1 Peter 4:8*
- *If I speak with the tongues of men and of angels, but do not have love, I have become a noisy gong or a clanging cymbal. If I have the gift of prophecy, and know all mysteries and all knowledge; and if I have all faith, so as to remove mountains, but do not have love, I am nothing. And if I give all my possessions to feed the poor, and if I surrender my body to be burned, but do not have love, it profits me nothing. -- 1 Corinthians 13*
- *Love is patient, love is kind and is not jealous; love does not brag and is not arrogant. -- 1 Corinthians 13:4*
- *But the fruit of the Spirit is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness. -- Galatians 5:22*

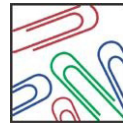
