Do We Get A Vacation From Church In The Summer?

My wife remembers when she was about five years old she and her parents were talking about where to go for their family vacation. She knew that school was out for the summer and her dad had a vacation coming so it was a natural discussion to have. And then she asked her mom and dad when there was a vacation from church. They quickly assured her there was not. And I would add, "why would you want to?"

Is there a tendency among believers to take a little time off from worshipping God in the summer? When school is out in May do we think we hear God say "See you back full-time in the fall!" When you go on vacation do you feel like you are exempt from Hebrews 10:25? In our travels we have found many fine congregations of the Lord's people. If attending a local congregation where we are staying is not possible we and our traveling companions have held our own services. This too is a very rewarding experience and I trust is still worshipping God "in spirit and in truth."

Many would throw in the "God is everywhere in nature" card here. Some would argue "It's such a beautiful day today. God's creation is beautiful and He would want me to enjoy it. Today, instead of being with the Lord's people in a worship service, I will worship Him in His majesty - at the beach." After using this logic for a while the thought enters the mind, "I don't need church to have a relationship with God." Obviously, we can feel close to God outside of the Estes building, but are you using this line of reasoning to benefit your own self-centered interest?

Last week after the Wednesday evening Bible Study, several of the Estes family were standing in the parking lot when someone noticed the beautiful sunset as the sun was trying to hide behind the clouds that were beginning to form from tropical storm Cindy. It was truly beautiful and I could see God in that scene. Seeing that while in the presence of several of my Estes family made it even better. God wanted us to assemble for a good reason. We need it. We need fellow Christians to help build us up. We need fellow Christians to encourage us when we're down. We need fellow Christians to help us become stronger in faith. We need each other. When you are on vacation, take the opportunity to worship God with your much larger Christian family and be encouraged by them. There is no substitute for corporate worship. Don't take a vacation from God. He doesn't take a vacation from you.
