Behind the Mask

Halloween is rapidly approaching as the temperature drops, leaves begin to fall, and endless thoughts of sugar and candy flood the minds of young children (and adults). This special day also holds a unique tradition where it is common, if not expected, for participants young and old to put on a costume and a mask while they pretend to be something that they really are not. Practices such as this can be fun and entertaining as we enjoy seeing disguises that are frightening and sometimes laughable; however, what happens when this practice mimics our relationship with God?

Jesus often accused the Pharisees of outwardly pretending to be followers of God, while inwardly they were corrupt. When comparing them to whitewashed tombs, Jesus offered a firm warning to the Pharisees saying that they "appear righteous to men, but inwardly...are full of hypocrisy and lawlessness" (Mt. 23:28). Earlier, Jesus warned His disciples against giving, praying, and fasting simply to be seen by other people (Mt. 6:2, 5, 16). In each of these instances, if the motivation of the disciple derived solely from impressing others, Jesus told them plainly "they have their reward in full."

Our motives can reveal the condition of our hearts. If we worship the Father, serve our neighbors, or perform any good work simply to be noticed by other people, then we too have our reward in full. When God is no longer our audience, we may also appear righteous to men but inwardly be full of hypocrisy and lawlessness. While Halloween is a day where we can pretend to be something that we really are not, God does not want followers who are simply pretending. Let us ensure we are not wearing a mask to look like a Christian, but rather, let us allow our hearts to reveal our true identity.
