Love Languages

First published in 1995, Gary Chapman wrote *The Five Love Languages*. The premise of the book resides in the fact that men and women are different. Nine years later, Emerson Eggerichs wrote *Love and Respect* which centered on the very same premise. Understanding men and women are different is relatively easy. Making application has proven a very difficult task over time.

Ephesians 5:21 says Christians should be "...submitting to one another in the fear of God." The language scholars conclude that the English word fear in this passage communicates a message not found in the original language. The passage does not teach that Christians should be afraid (terrified) of their Father. Other passages describe God to the contrary. However, the scholars conclude there is no good English word to communicate the gravity (solemnness) the saved should have toward Jehovah. The thrust of the Greek gets lost in the translation.

It is interesting that Paul moves from this solemn respect to the roles of husbands and wives in the home. Husbands are instructed to love their wives (literally, put the needs of their wives above their own – How did Christ love the church?) and wives are to focus on the overall submission of God's design.

It is also interesting how Paul encourages husbands and wives to focus solely on their own roles. The text does not tell husbands to force their wives to respect them. Nor does the text tell wives to annoy their husbands into loving them. Such a tactic was proven ineffective long ago. The text encourages people to focus on themselves. Husbands are to work on what they can do. They are to focus on loving their wives. Wives are to work on what they can do. They are to focus on respecting their husbands. After all, each will stand for their own individual actions.

Paul concludes with a powerful summary in verse 33: "Nevertheless let each one of you in particular so love his own wife as himself, and let the wife see that she respects her husband." The key word for husbands is agape. The key word for wives is respect. Interestingly, the word translated respect in verse 33 is the same word translated fear in verse 21. It is clear that men and women are different (something God knew before the family experts) and perhaps Chapman's love languages can be broadly categorized into two languages – agape and respect.
