LET'S "DIG DEEPER" FOR THE REST OF 2018

As summer gets underway let's remind ourselves of one of the things we are doing at Estes in 2018. In January the Estes family began reading through the New Testament together. As we have sought to go deeper in exploring God's Word we have had daily Facebook posts and emails, weekly sermons from a text we have read the previous week, and the His Word books that were distributed to members of the congregation at the beginning of the year. The banners in the front of the auditorium and the frequent correspondences regarding this reading plan have been good reminders. It's difficult to believe that on June 13 we will begin reading Paul's letter to the Romans and for the first time be reading a text outside the Gospel accounts and Acts. The Gospel accounts and Acts include 117 of the 260 chapters in the NT, meaning that nearly 45% of the NT is contained within the first five books!

Why say all of this? Perhaps as the year has moved on you have fallen behind on your reading. If you have I want to encourage you to jump back in. Perhaps you have managed to keep up with our daily Bible readings. If you have kept up with your reading every weekday this year I want to encourage you to take your study to the next level. If you haven't been reading consider joining the rest of the congregation where we are at this point in the year (a reading schedule is available on the Estes website or at the Welcome Center). Do not allow falling behind to become a reason not to read! Take advantage of the daily content written by one of our Estes members or even the content in the His Word books that provide a page of content for each of the chapters in the NT. As you read try to anticipate what passage we are reading will the sermon (it might be Sunday morning or evening depending on the month) the following week will be on. Try making notes in your Bible or seeking to bring home at least one application from the text each day that will bless you in your daily walk. Try reading the chapter in two different translations or even listening to the passage read aloud by someone else to make the most of your daily time in the Word. Treat this as an opportunity to being intentional about spending time in study of the Word. Find someone in the congregation or take time with friends or family to discuss the chapter you have read that day as a way of stimulating more reflection as well.

Not only will you be blessed by more time spent in the Word, but you can begin to develop even more good habits when it comes to reflecting on what God has revealed to us. Imagine the blessings that will come if we dig even deeper in the Word of God in the second half of 2018!
