As Pilate cross-examined Jesus, searching for anything He might have done to warrant the force of Roman law, he asked Jesus a simple question: "What is truth (John 18:38)?" This question Pilate asked has, in recent times, been the springboard for questions about the nature of truth and morality. Is truth subjective, fluid, and perhaps unattainable, or is it absolute and knowable? These are big questions to ask. Scripture frequently asserts its own truth and authority, and so how we answer these questions is of great importance. If we stop there, however, we may miss something in Pilate's interchange with Jesus that reveals something else about truth. Right before Pilate's question, Jesus said that He came into the world to "bear witness to the truth (v. 37)." Notice Jesus did not say He came to establish the reality of absolute truth. The Jews already acknowledged that reality. Jesus came instead to bear witness to what that truth was. And what was that truth? It was certainly not what the Jews were expecting, or they would not have delivered Jesus over to death. The truth was that the Word became flesh and dwelt among us (1:14), that God so loved the world that He gave His only Son (3:16), that Jesus is the good shepherd (10:14), that His kingdom was not of this world (18:36), and that Jesus was even truth itself (14:6)! This is not only truth, this is good news! Truth is something to examine and submit to. For Christians, however, it is also something to find joy in. Our sins are forgiven, our relationship with God is restored, glory awaits us, Christ and the Holy Spirit intercede for us, the body of believers builds us up, and we can grow in the grace and knowledge of our Lord Jesus Christ. Let us rejoice in God's truth!
