Elder Nominations

the Elders at Estes

Paul in writing to Titus instructed Titus to set in order the things that were lacking in Crete, one of those things being the appointment of elders.

Paul goes on to list qualities or characteristics of men who could serve in that position.

Though all congregations today may not have men to serve as elders, for those congregations that have men capable, it is expedient that those men serve who are willing, and who meet those qualities.

Having a faithful eldership is two-fold. Those who serve as elders are accountable to God for the flock they shepherd. At the same time, when men are considered and approved by the congregation, the congregation agrees to submit to those elders as long as their leadership is in harmony with God's word and His will.

The elders are submitting three men to you who we feel meet these qualities, and we ask you to consider these men, prove their abilities, and if accepted agree to serve under their authority and leadership.

We are asking you to consider, talk to, and pray for: Dan Ayers, Jason Lockridge, and Kevin Moore.

If for any reason during the next two weeks you think these men should not serve, we would ask you to meet with them, meet with the current elders, or submit your view in writing to one of the current elders.

TITUS 1:5-9

5 This is why I left you in Crete, so that you might put what remained into order, and appoint elders in every town as I directed you— 6 if anyone is above reproach, the husband of one wife, and his children are believers and not open to the charge of debauchery or insubordination. 7 For an overseer, as God's steward, must be above reproach. He must not be arrogant or quick-tempered or a drunkard or violent or greedy for gain, 8 but hospitable, a lover of good, self-controlled, upright, holy, and disciplined. 9 He must hold firm to the trustworthy word as taught, so that he may be able to give instruction in sound doctrine and also to rebuke those who contradict it.
