Numbers cannot depict the servant hearts of our youth group cleaning up our cabin after every one of our meals—many times, without being asked or reminded. Nor can numbers describe the focused mindset and positive attitude of our group throughout the entire weekend.

We also heard three additional devotionals while we stayed in our cabin. Each lesson helped us prepare our minds for the "Unashamed" theme of CYC. The following lessons are also attitudes we hope to carry with us in the upcoming year and throughout the rest of our lives:

Unashamed of His Cross. We want others to see our love for Jesus and our devotion to Him. It is our goal to tell others of His love for the entire world and not be ashamed.

Unashamed of Our Cross. Jesus expects us to take up a cross and follow Him. We seek to make sacrifices for Him as He sacrificed all for us.

Unashamed of Their Cross. Everyone bears a cross. Sometimes help is needed in order to bear that cross. We want to help others around us bear the cross that they carry.

This year's trip to CYC has easily been my favorite Estes Youth Group trip so far! I am proud of our young people for their focus, commitment, and love for Jesus. Our youth group is also thankful for the many adults and chaperones who helped make this trip possible.
