# Let's Be Thoughtful About How We Dress

### THE ELDERS

#### **Perception matters**

How the church is perceived by the world is an important consideration, as well as how we view one another. To give no offense is a worthy aim (1 Cor. 10:32-33). What does our standard of dress reflect about our character and priorities? Being clothed with Christ (Gal. 3:26), with holiness and honor (1 Thess. 4:4-7), with godliness and good works (1 Tim. 2:10), and with a gentle and quiet spirit (1 Pet. 3:4) are reflected in our outward appearance. God is to be glorified instead of drawing the attention to ourselves.

#### **Holiness matters**

What we wear should not be a distraction to others, especially as we assemble to worship. Holiness looks beyond self (1 Pet. 1:13-17). Clothing, or the lack thereof, that draws attention to one's sexuality is inappropriate. When scripture calls for "modest apparel" (1 Tim. 2:9-10), the admonition is against dressing in such a way that directs the focus of onlookers to one's outer adornment rather than one's inner virtue. If my heart is nonchalant or vain in its approach to worship and is manifested in how I dress, merely changing clothes won't change the heart. But a change of heart will surely impact what I choose to wear.

#### Summer

With summer approaching, as with all seasons, let's all be mindful of what is communicated by how we dress. Without providing specific and universal measurements or guidelines, the Bible does affirm the basic principle of modest attire. Not everyone shares the same convictions about what is modest or immodest, but we can strive for balance and avoid extremes. May we be humble and selfless as we seek to honor God and consider how our fashion choices affect and influence those around us.

# 1 TIMOTHY **2:9-10**

9 I also want the women to dress modestly, with decency and propriety, adorning themselves, not with elaborate hairstyles or gold or pearls or expensive clothes, 10 but with good deeds, appropriate for women who profess to worship God.
