This past Sunday we launched our new local outreach program and are encouraging all Estes members to be involved. The first step is to sign up for one or more of the following areas of service:

1. **Scouts:** identify people in need of finding the life God intended.
2. **Bible Study Teachers:** engaged in evangelistic Bible studies.
3. **Encouragers:** connecting and making visitors and new members feel welcome in the Estes family.
4. **Mentors:** fostering Christian maturity among believers to help them grow in the Christian life.

If you haven't had the opportunity to sign up yet, you can communicate your preference(s) to Kevin Moore. All Estes members are encouraged to regularly pray for our outreach efforts.

Harold Pirtle has set up an online database accessible to everyone signed up to participate in the program. It contains the names and contact details of those who expressed interest in Bible study at our last Trunk or Treat event, and information will be revised and added as needed. When everyone has had the opportunity to sign up, and the respective outreach groups are coordinated (please be patient as Spring Break is upon us!), a brief meeting will be held with each group to answer questions, get feedback, and keep the proverbial ball rolling that was launched on Sunday. When initial connections are made, follow up will continue at least every two weeks until circumstances dictate otherwise.

We have a new brochure (thanks Trent Scott) to give to each person we meet - at the initial contact, follow-up visit, or greeting visitors to our assemblies. It is an introduction to the Estes church with information about who we are, what we do, ministries, meeting times, and contact details. The brochures are currently available in the lobby behind the welcome center. We also have a bi-fold business card that can be given or left behind with a personal note, also available at the welcome center.

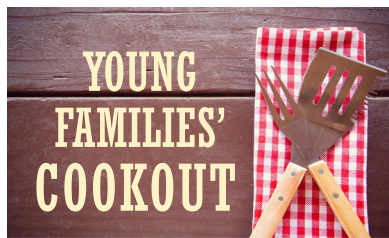
