## WHY I LOVE THE CHURCH

No words can adequately express my love for the church. But why do I love her so? In Paul's letter to the Ephesians he mentioned the Lord's church in nine places. In one of these passages in particular I am reminded of how the church has encouraged me. In Ephesians 4:11-16 Paul mentions the roles (apostles, prophets, evangelists, pastors and teachers) that God "gave" the church in v. 11, but then shares the primary responsibility of these leaders in v. 12 - church leaders serve to equip saints for ministry and service. Furthermore, the reason these roles exist is "for the building up of the body." The results of church leaders serving according to God's intent is described in vv. 13-15. When church leaders lead as God instructed, the unity, ability, maturity, stability, and charity of God's people is made evident (along with the future reward in v. 16).

The church is a fellowship of hope where members share a common past, present, and future despite their diversity because of the difference that Christ had made. If I love the Christ then I cannot help but love His bride. When the church functions as God intended, God's people have all sorts of opportunities to find this kind of encouragement.

I also love the church because she has met my needs. The early church provided for one another while also impacting those around them for good (Gal. 2:10) as Jesus himself did. When I have found myself in want of care, God's people have cared for me.

Furthermore, I love the church because she has taught me the Gospel. I cannot even count the teachers, preachers, and leaders who have taught me the Gospel throughout my life. When the plan of how the church ought to work is lived out, then benevolence and teaching follow the encouragement we receive in Christ. The ministry that was modeled by our Savior must now be replicated by church leaders who in turn seek to equip God's people to do likewise.

Finally, I am reminded that I also love the church because she disciplines me. The church helps me to overcome sin and holds me accountable when I fail to do so. Without discipline the church loses her moorings and no longer exemplifies the holiness that sets her apart. If I truly love the church, my words should never slander the body of the Lord. The church has given me so much. She has encouraged me, cared for me, taught me, and disciplined me. May I not forget the blessing that the church of our Lord is in the present. I love the church, don't you?
